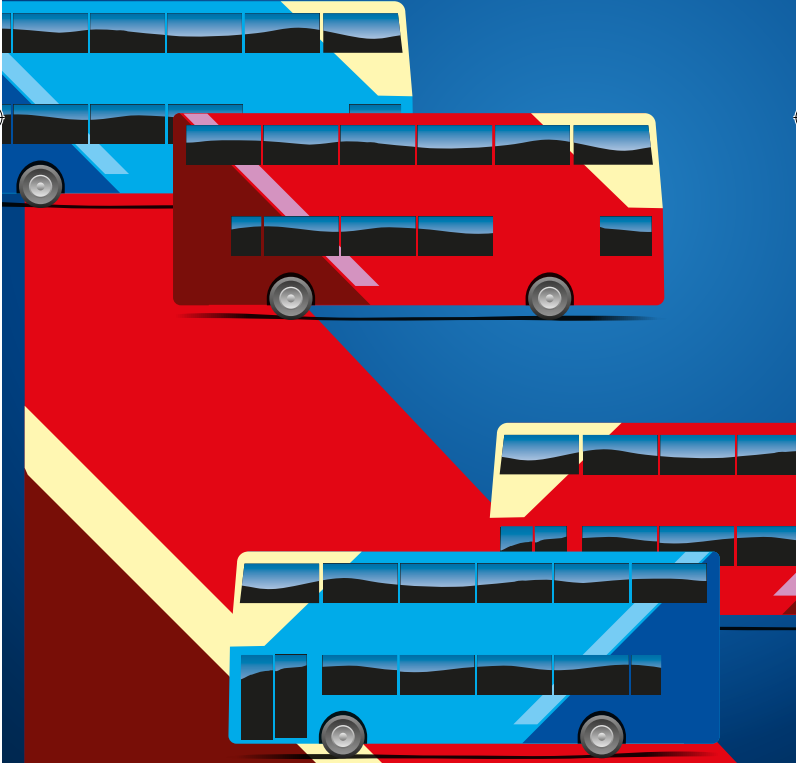

new numbers


Some services will be renumbered to make it easier to remember where our buses go and remove confusion where the same number used for a different route within the South Yorkshire bus network.

All Doncaster bus routes are being renumbered into the 300 range. And our popular services between Sheffield, Meadowhall and Rotherham will be renumbered to X1, X2 and X3, making them easier to remember and identify.

After the recent public consultation process, you gave us excellent, constructive feedback, and we've taken on board many of your suggestions.

We work closely with SYMCA and have taken on board other suggestions you've made with a plan to make further improvements later in the year.

This change is the result of requests to reinstate a through service between Rotherham, Wickersley, Fladnderwell, Bramley, Hellaby, Maltby, Braithwell, Edlington, Balby and Doncaster.

Previous X10 journeys (re-numbered X2) will extend every hour to Doncaster via what was the 10 route.

All journeys will operate via Brightside.

We're bringing in a Sunday service to parts of the previous X10 that previously did not have a service.

Between Sheffield and Rotherham, all buses will run through Brightside and Masbrough (previously served by the X78), with times changed. This will mean 4 buses an hour, making it better for anyone working in that area.

Buses will run via Attercliffe between Sheffield and Rotherham (previously served by X1/X10), with changes to times.

This route will continue beyond Dinnington to Maltby, serving Thurcroft, Bramley and Hellaby hourly.

This will make it easier for anyone working at Hellaby or Maltby and give a direct link to Sheffield from Thurcroft and Laughton Common.
